THE ART OF COMMERCE
What it lacks in elephants and cotton candy, Art Basel Miami Beach makes up for in socialites, product launches, and a three-ring atmosphere of another sort. The four-day contemporary art fair, which begins today, set up camp in the seedy downtown Miami neighborhood of Wynwood in 2002 and has since evolved into a see-and-be-seen event that knows more from 15-minute celebrities and big-name DJs than starving artists. This year, 220 galleries will be showing works by over 1,500 artists in the main exhibition center alone, while satellite events around town—like a pig roast-cum-performance art piece, a fashion show from Alberta Ferretti, and the Cartier-sponsored fete expected to last until the wee hours—should keep hangers-on busy.
